-  **Our first library session will be on Friday 25th September.** Children will choose a library book each week to bring home to share with you. These are a mix of fiction and non-fiction picture books, traditional and modern. We will encourage the children to choose a new book each time but be prepared for an old favourite to return in their book bag from time to time! Please make sure books are back in bags every Friday.

-  **Please ensure your child has their named water bottle in their hand** when coming into Nursery each morning so that they can easily put it into the correct basket.



Please ensure that your child has a set of spare clothes in their peg bag, depending on your child, you may need to include 3 or 4 sets. Any clothes sent home wet or soiled should please be returned, washed, the following day. Thank you.



Gate safety – please wait behind the Nursery gate each morning when bringing children to school, until a member of staff opens the Nursery door and gate. Please arrive at your allocated time each day (8.45-9.00 or 9.15 or 12.15). Thank you.



At Blossomfield we are fortunate to be part of a research project alongside the Open University. This project will help us to encourage children to read for pleasure.
